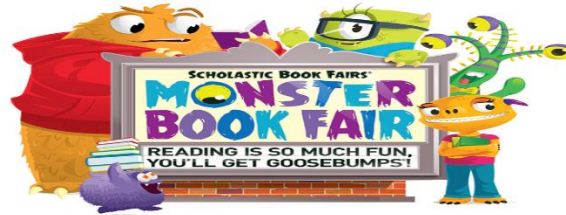




## 2015 ISL Book Fair
